Pouilly-Fuisse is the best white wine of the Macon region of France. This wine can be chardonnay at it's best. It goes well with egg dishes, fish and lobster.

Sauvignon Blanc

Another white wine grape that can scan many different flavor profiles according to where it was grown (climate) and how it was made (oak aging). The French identify the place name as label title. For example, *Sancerre* as opposed to the grape name, *Sauvignon Blanc*. The natural acidity from the grape makes these wines very versatile with a wide variety of foods from shellfish to salads.
